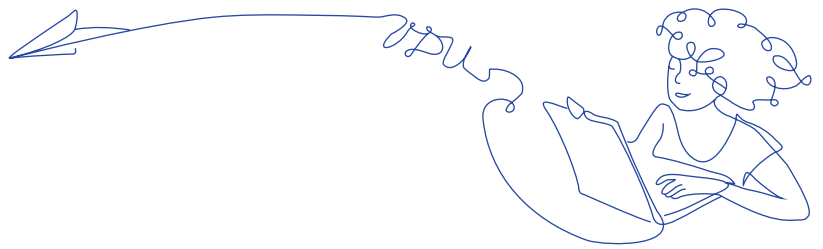

<p>„How to manage goals and priorities in everyday flow“. During the webinar we would like to find the answer for some questions: where is the real challenge? Is it the matter of setting or achieving goals? Is it the matter of what methods and approaches to use, how to better manage workload, your focus & energy (cognitive aspects) and/or work-life alignment (work & life roles and goals)? We are going to see what is every participant's biggest challenge in setting goals and priorities. We are going to see different examples of goals and priorities setting approaches and models (e.g. WOOP, Eisenhower matrix, focus management and shaping the rhythm of working life). During the webinar we will try to learn how to design working life (e.g. work-life roles design, job crafting).</p>	Non-Academic Staff	Lecturer Anna Gramberg (Estonian Academy of Arts) is a professional career coach, certified career specialist and trainer. <p>„Anatomy of a Higher-Education Teacher and Active Learning Methods“. The webinar topics: Teacher identity, Student-centred vs. teacher-centred teaching, Active learning methods, The importance of asking the right questions. Participants will be able to: recognise different dimensions of the role of the teacher in higher education; reflect on their own role as teachers in higher education using metaphors as reflective tools and drawing on the social constructivist paradigm of learning; discuss the advantages of a student-centred approach to learning and studying at the university level; identify various active learning methods used in higher education teaching and evaluate their advantages and effectiveness; design questions aimed at promoting higher-order thinking skills based on Bloom's taxonomy.</p>	Academic staff	Lecturers – Associate Professor Dr. Silva Bratož, Assistant Professor Dr. Anja Pirih at the University of Primorska. This seminar offers an in-depth exploration of advanced „Microsoft Excel“ functionalities, focusing on practical applications of sorting, filtering, and conditional formatting. Participants will learn the techniques required for efficiently managing and analyzing data and enhance their ability to present and interpret data with greater precision and effectiveness.
