

Join a T4EU PhD JUNIOR LAB with PhD fellows from throughout Europe!

The Transform4Europe Junior Labs are temporary structures led by PhD students from the alliance who are already enrolled in PhD studies at T4EU universities.

The fundamental goals of the T4EU junior laboratories are to promote interdisciplinarity, facilitate PhD collaborations within the alliance, and establish international connections and experience that will be valuable in a future career.

Junior Labs are developed for a maximum of two years. Each of the lab will appoint a project leader that must be enrolled in PhD studies at one of the T4EU universities during the term of the project. Fellow PhD students in the network must also be part of a T4EU university

The review of the applications for the Junior Labs will be organized by the Joint PhD Office.

The first call for Junior Labs is open in from June 2025 with a submission deadline September 30th 2025. The notification will take place end of November 2025.

Support documents for a Junior Lab application

To apply for a Junior Lab set up, the following files are required.

1. Describe the Junior Lab's goals, including:

- the project's current state;
- the team's complementarity;
- the multidisciplinary approach's contribution and the methodology used to accomplish the goals;
- the advantages for Junior Lab members;
- the Junior Lab's purpose and reporting procedures (writing of articles/publication, organization of roundtables, research log, scientific outreach activities, organization of conferences, create awareness on a specific topic, exchanging on best practices in methodology, organize seminars or webinars etc.);
- the advantages for T4EU

2. Junior Lab members' list (name, lab, email address, CV, and thesis project summary; list the person in charge first).

3. Projected timeline (start and finish dates, milestones, maximum of two years).
