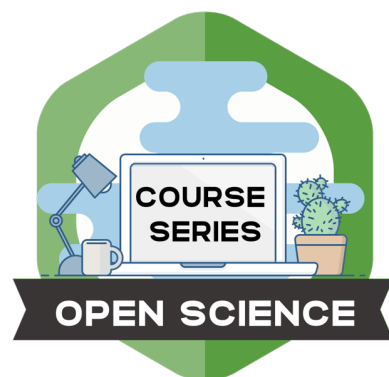


We invite **academic staff, researchers, PhD students, and students** to our **Open Science Course Series**, starting in February 2026 **online**.
